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Permission Note to complete Study Hall from home

The timetable for semester 1 2024 includes a Study Hall session in the afternoon on Mondays (see attached letter with more information). During the Monday Pastoral Care session students will identify goals for their learning for that afternoon. The Study Hall sessions will allow for students to complete supervised self-directed learning with teachers, LSAs and youth workers present to assist where needed. The 10A extension mathematics class will occur during the Study Hall time of 1.45pm – 3pm.

We recognise that many students, particularly those in years 9 and 10, are well suited to completing this type of learning at home. This is good preparation for post-high school options, particularly the College environment. Students who do their learning from home will be marked as participating in a 'structured learning activity' for that afternoon.

All students will be required to complete a check-in and check-out via their PC Google Classroom page where they document their learning goals for the Study Hall session and then reflect on what they have achieved at the end of the session. These goals and reflections will be reviewed in the following Monday Pastoral Care session.
