Enrolment applications for 2021 Year 7s and Year 11s are now open. The link to the online application form is below. Parents/carers are asked to submit their enrolment form by 5th June in order to receive their offer in the first round in late July. Completing your enrolment form by 5th June helps schools to prepare effectively for the following school year. It provides time for information transfer and transition activities, as well as planning for subject sections for students going to college. All students are required to be attending school or in formal study (e.g. CIT) or work until the age of 17. So please contact the school if your child wishes to seek pathways other than college.

SENIOR HASS OPTIONS IN 2020

This year at Lanyon High School we had planned to offer our senior students the opportunity to choose from a range of options for semester two of HASS (Humanities and Social Sciences), after completing their compulsory History component in semester one. However as a result of the disruption caused by COVID-19 we have decided to change this plan for 2020.

Students will now stay in their current HASS class into semester two. In this class they will study Geography and then either Introduction to Business and Economics (Year 9) or Civics and Citizenship (Year 10).
