For any technical problems with a Chromebook, please initially contact the Lanyon Front Office(61421800) and ask to speak with Mark Searle(ITO) if this is on a Tuesday/Thursday/Friday. Otherwise, please drop the device into the Front Office for action on repairs to the Chromebook. During the online learning period, if a Chromebook is faulty, you will receive a second-hand Chromebook on loan for your child until the faulty Chromebook is repaired.

Password resets:

If a student requires a password reset, please contact the Lanyon Front Office(61421800) and ask to speak with Mark Searle(ITO) if this is on a Tuesday/Thursday/Friday. Otherwise, ask to speak to any teacher who will be able to reset the password.
